## SBH-ASO – Recovery Navigator Program


- Intended as referral source for law enforcement and community. 9am - 5pm currently, hoping to expand hours.
   (Will partner with other county navigators.)
- Funding is intended for: a street outreach program;
   to fill gaps; to avoid overstepping existing programs;
   and to cohere on-the-ground efforts.
- This is not a Crisis Response Program, or part
   of the crisis system. This program focuses on
   equitable access and diversion (many steps before ITA.)
- Program has peer-oriented staffing requirements.
- On the horizon: Funding for Peer Enhancement to Crisis Teams

Capital Improvement funds of \$50,000 for critical home repairs for 5 homes in Brinnon for persons at 50% AMI or less.






### Harm Reduction Training Resource

NASTAD's Drug User Health Team is pleased to announce the publication of a new resource,
National Harm Reduction Technical Assistance Center (NHRTAC) Training Deck on Harm Reduction
and Syringe Access. The NHRTAC Training Deck on Harm Reduction and Syringe Access is a
customizable PowerPoint training designed to provide an overview on the foundations of harm
reduction philosophy and practice, drug user health issues and trends, and to increase cultural
competence and humility when serving people who use drugs. NASTAD developed this training
resource in consultation with our regional TA consultants and other harm reduction subject matter
experts. Could be shared with

- State, local and tribal health department staff working with drug user health programs, harm reduction programs, or other public health services for people who use drugs;
- Syringe access program staff, participants, or community members/partners;
- General public seeking information on harm reduction and drug user health.

Training participants will be able to define harm reduction, describe the principles of harm reduction practice, provide examples of harm reduction for people who use drugs, understand the significance of syringe access and safer drug use for individual and public health, and increase knowledge of health and social risk factors related to injecting, smoking, and snorting substances.
