

Statement of Issue: Grantee requests approval to purchase a Naloxone/Harm Reduction Vending Machine to be installed at the Brinnon Community Center, located at the southern end of Jefferson County, for use during and beyond the grant performance period ending 8/31/2023. The quote includes freight charges; charges for the required vending machine software licensing for three years and three years of preventative maintenance; for a total cost of \$23,511.05, to support increasing naloxone distribution in Jefferson County. Analysis/Strategic Goals: This request addresses core grant P5, T4, T7 and R2 highlighted in blue on the graphic. The Behavioral Health Consortium (BHC) Members intend this Naloxone Vending machine purchase, and the requested support for the related expenses of software licensing and maintenance contract, to provide improvement of access to life-saving Naloxone medication in a geographically remote part of our rural county.
