Mobile Harm Reduction (MHR) Update

- Working to meet with south county community partners to establish a schedule and locations.
- Working bring the mobile unit to Quilcene/Brinnon and beyond within the next couple weeks to establish a presence and start providing services no later than August 15.
- BiR's mobile SUD clinic is able to provide the same services they provide in office: SUD assessments, relapse prevention, outpatient and intensive outpatient group sessions, urine drug testing, peer support, and individual counseling.
- BiR is partnered with OPHS to provide inductions and medication maintenance.
- Gateway to Freedom will be supplying goods
 - clothing, toiletries, tents/sleeping bags, etc.



MHR Discussion

Clarifying Needs:

Brainstorm a few basic on-the-ground questions that Believe In Recovery could ask to help this group (and the County as a whole) to develop better inputs on the needs/usage patterns? This would be valuable as the BHC works to improve the BH/SUD system as a whole. Examples:


- Are you using the fentanyl pills (we are specifically interested in counterfeit pills as they are often smoked, rather than injected)
- If yes, has your injection use reduced due to smoking drugs (fentanyl) more often?
- Have you noticed if friends who had been injecting opioids, now decreasing injection use, but whose use is now mostly smoking fentanyl?
- *If we were able to distribute safer smoking supplies, do you have a sense if think people would make the trip out to see us?

*Let folks know we do not distribute safe smoking supplies currently, but are gathering data.






 Creative approaches to help induction patients connect to prescriptions without driving them to faraway pharmacies?


