




2021 Survey overview





Frequency of drug use n=955




Main drug heroin





- 54% smoked, vaped or dabbed cannabis








What is your MAIN reason for... smoking opioids? smoking stimulants?










Peer networks of people who do NOT inject








Opioid overdoses had, last 12 months

among those who had used opioids n=764










Opioid overdose by fentanyl use

Had at least 1 opioid OD in last 12 months (n=751)





Opioid overdoses witnessed, last 12 months






In the past 3 months, have you ever felt like you were...

HEALTH CARE TOPICS





Health-related responses

92% have health insurance. Of those, 83% have Medicaid.

HIV testing:

- 44% within last year
- 45% over a year ago
- 11% never tested

Syphilis testing in last 12 months?

- 71% No
- 6% Not sure
- 23% Yes → 14% of these (n=29) were told they <u>had</u> syphilis.
- 3% (n=30) had been told by a sex partner or public health worker that they had been exposed to syphilis.

•	Abscesses,	skin infections	38%

• Blood clot/infection 6%






ER use and incarceration

Were you in jail or prison in the past 12 months?



Hepatitis C diagnosis and treatment








Covid diagnosis & vaccination

- 11% had been diagnosed with Covid, 3% unsure.
- "No vaccination" ranged from 46% 84%.
- Unvaccinated rates generally higher in more rural areas.




Covid vaccination interest

- Interest in COVID vaccination was generally low but varied by county.
- By county, highest levels of vaccination uncertainty ("not sures") were often in more rural counties where rates of vaccination were often the lowest. *Opportunity???*

Among those who were not vaccinated n= 587








MENTAL HEALTH AND DRUG TREATMENT

36% were *very concerned* about anxiety.


20% were very concerned about both.

In the past 12 months, what types of drug treatment, if any, did you get? (n=955)








Drug treatment by main drug
